  1. **Groups with valid UWO PeopleSoft Financial Accounts:** the above noted funds will be transferred into your respective account - this is the preferred process.
  2. **Students Groups/Clubs:** request funding in person to Mr. Lonnie Wickman, Manager, Financial Resources (EB 2003C; [lwickman@uwo.ca](mailto:lwickman@uwo.ca)).
  3. **Conference/Events:** submit a UWO travel claim upon return from event to obtain reimbursement up to your approved funding - see Engineering Financial Services Office EB 2002.
  4. **All Other:** for project expenditures you can either have the item(s) purchased directly by UWO via the use of a purchase order, account charge or corporate VISA or purchase the items yourself and obtain a reimbursement (up to your funding awarded) by submitting a UWO travel claim - please see Engineering Financial Services Office EB 2002.
- **Funding Criteria:** *the awarding of funding under this initiative includes the future accessibility of any apparatus or equipment partially or wholly funded by the Engineering Students, with the intent on the items remaining in the Faculty.*
