

John Booker Award

Distinguished scientist, engineer, researcher who, while a professor at the University of Sydney, had close research collaboration with the GRC

He was one of the finest researchers working in the field of theoretical geomechanics



Special consideration will be given to students working in the area of dynamics and soil-structure







L.G. Soderman Award

The Soil Mechanics Section of the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at Western was started in 1965 by L.G. Soderman and was one of the first Soil Mechanics Sections in Canada

He was the driving force behind the founding of the company Golder

Preference will be given to a student whose research has shown potential industrial application


