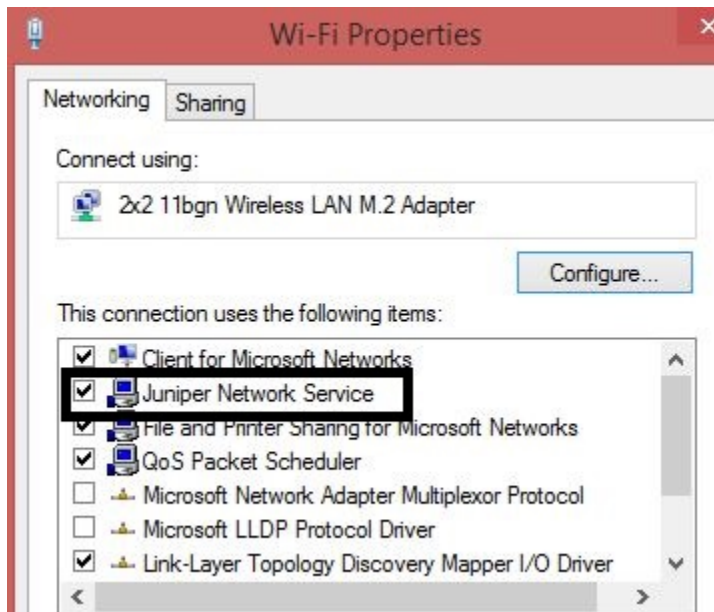
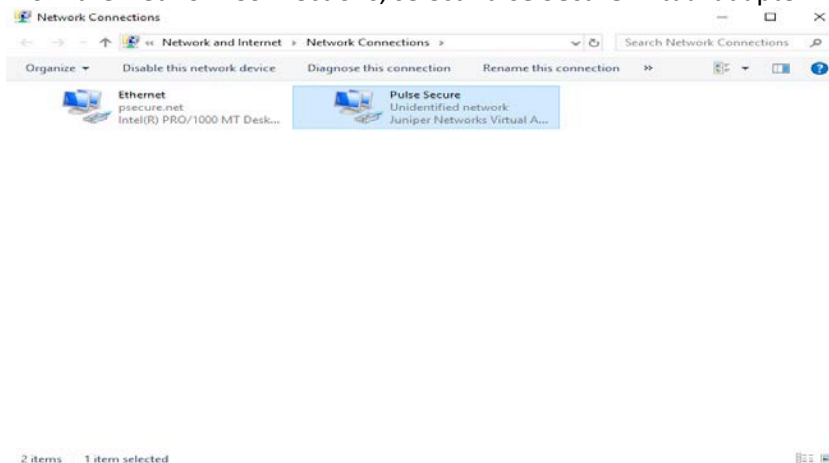


Disable the Juniper Network Services from the physical and virtual adapter

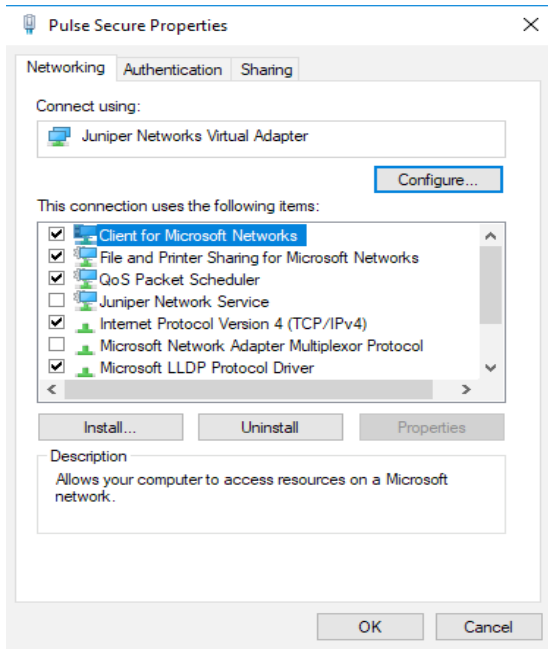
1. Open *Control Panel* and select *Network and Sharing Center* then select *Change adapter settings*.
OR
From a DOS command prompt run the command:
-Start > Run > ncpa.cpl
2. Locate the physical adapter in the Network Connections
3. Right-click on the adapter and select **Properties**.
4. From the list, uncheck the checkbox for **Juniper Network Service**



5. Connect with Pulse Desktop Client. (This is necessary to change the virtual adapter settings. If the Pulse tunnel is not connected, the virtual adapter does not appear in the Network Connections.)
6. From the Network Connections, select **Pulse Secure** virtual adapter



7. Right-click the adapter and select **Properties**
8. From the list, uncheck the checkbox for **Juniper Network Service** & Click OK



Alternatively, the same can be achieved upon running the following command from PowerShell (Running as an Admin)

```
Disable-NetAdapterBinding -Name * -DisplayName "Juniper Network Service"
```

Note : Replace * with specific Adapter display name if you do not wish to disable "Juniper Network Service" on all the adapters.
