

Western Engineering Outreach is committed to removing barriers to STEM (science, technology, engineering and math), and being financially accessible to all members of our community is part of this. We believe that STEM is for everyone.

Who qualifies?

Anyone who is unable to participate in a Discovery Western program due to financial barriers. Families unable to pay for the full registration fee for Western Engineering Outreach programming are encouraged to apply.

How much assistance does Western Engineering Outreach Provide?

- Western Engineering Outreach will cover 85% of a program's registration fee. The parent/guardian is responsible for covering the remaining 15% of the fee. We do not provide full fee assistance.
- Financial assistance is limited to two bursaries per household per calendar year.
- The portion of the registration fee covered by Western Engineering Outreach is ineligible for a refund in the event your child(ren) is unable to attend our program.
- Please see our Registration Portal for up-to-date registration fees.
- We recognize that every family's situation is unique. In addition to family income, other circumstances that pose a barrier to participation are also taken into consideration.
- While we strive to fulfill as many requests for financial assistance as possible, we have limited funds available each year. We cannot guarantee that we will be able to provide assistance to everyone who applies. Eligible applications for financial assistance are assessed on a first-come-first-served basis while funds are available.

How do I apply?

1. Register your child for a Discovery Western program. The full program fee is due at registration.
2. Complete the following Financial Assistance Form.
3. Email a completed copy of the form to discover@uwo.ca.
4. A member of the Discovery Western team will contact you if we are able to provide financial assistance, and to confirm the amount and payment method.
