One \$1,500 (CDN) scholarship is available through each of the six CPCI Regional Chapters (British Columbia, Alberta, Manitoba/Saskatchewan, Ontario, Quebec and Maritimes) for Engineering or Engineering Technology students entering their final year of study in September 2019.

The successful candidates from each region will also be paired with a precaster in their geographic area to learn more about precast and prestressed concrete, precast operations, and opportunities in the industry.

This scholarship is open to students currently enrolled in a third year bachelor's program in Engineering at an accredited university program, proceeding in good standing into fourth year by the summer of 2019. The scholarship is also open to students enrolled in their final year of Engineering Technology at an accredited college.

Graduate Students in Civil Engineering

CPCI will present one \$15,000 (CDN) scholarship for graduate or post graduate studies in the field of precast or prestressed concrete related research, design or construction for the 2019-2020 academic year.
